



We are so incredibly thankful to God for his unfailing faithfulness to this media mission, and to you for your partnership in prayer and financial support. 2021 marks 60 years since Richard Berry committed himself to the call of establishing Christian radio in New Zealand. It took 17 years before the first permanent licence was granted but now, 43 years later, the country is blessed to have three radio networks operating on more than 100 licences, a TV channel that is accessible to every New Zealander through multiple platforms and two publications providing daily words of encouragement and Bible readings. God's faithfulness has continued through the last two generations of New Zealanders, and we look forward to continuing to reach this and future generations with the message of love and hope in Christ through media.

This year it was very exciting to have been able to successfully re-engineer Life FM's frequency licence that covered Porirua to a licence that covers the whole of Wellington City and the Hutt Valley. Like the pioneers of Christian radio in New Zealand back in the 60's and 70's there has been a lot of prayer, politics, negotiations and engineering that needed to be worked through and this took two years and eight months longer than anticipated. Life FM can now be heard by more than 377,000 people in Wellington and the Hutt and, as a bonus, it can also be heard on the upper east coast of the South Island.

This year the digital platforms have been strengthened with the release of new mobile apps for all three radio brands and Shine TV. The Shine App has made it even easier to access live streams and video on demand content and there has been a significant increase in audience for Shine TV this year.

Rhema Media is Christian media for New Zealand, and it is a delight to be able to continue to create New Zealand content that reflects Aotearoa, New Zealand from a biblical perspective. This happens daily through the radio programming and there has been continued growth in partnerships with churches and Christian organisations to extend their reach across New Zealand.

Through engaging content and the reach of the networks, every week hundreds of thousands of people in New Zealand are enabled to take their next right step in their journey of faith and personal relationship with Jesus Christ.

Thank you for being part of this Christian media mission through prayer and finances, and your encouraging words of support. We are grateful for each of you and for the dedicated and talented staff, our Board and our volunteers who have committed their time and expertise into the work of Rhema Media.

Journeying together to change lives ***Haere ngātahi hei hiki i te oranga***

God is the hero of the story of Rhema Media.

Ever since he planted the dream of Christian radio in the heart of Richard Berry in 1961, God has brought this media ministry into being and continued to sustain it and grow it in incredible ways.

After years of advocating and fighting for Christian radio in New Zealand, the first permanent Christian radio station went to air in Christchurch on the 11th November 1978. In 2021, three radio networks, one television network and two daily devotionals bless the entire country every day. This is all testament to a great and faithful God.

The 2020/2021 period has been unprecedented: the COVID-19 pandemic has rocked the whole world. Rhema Media, like all organisations, has been forced to operate in a different way – to designate essential workers to keep broadcasts going; to accelerate the adoption of online communications; to make plans for change in a suddenly uncertain future. But, God has shown his strong and powerful hand to make it possible for his Christian media ministry to keep impacting the people of Aotearoa, New Zealand.

But God does not desire to work alone; his heart is for people to co-labour with him.

Right in the beginning of his Word it says, 'The Lord God took the man and put him in the Garden of Eden to work it and take care of it' (Genesis 2:15 NIV). He entrusts man with decision making: 'So he took some soil from the ground and formed all the animals and all the birds. Then he brought them to the man to see what he would name them; and that is how they all got their names' (Genesis 2:19 GNT). And in 1 Corinthians 3:9 (GNT) we read: 'For we are partners working together for God, and you are God's field. You are also God's building.'

You, along with the Rhema Media staff, board members, volunteers and other supporters, are God's field. You have caught his vision to reveal himself to the people of New Zealand through your Christian media ministry, to draw them into an increasingly meaningful, personal relationship with his beloved Son, Jesus Christ. You are co-labouring with him to make it happen through your prayer and financial support.

Thank you for being part of the Rhema Media story. In this Annual Report for 2020/2021, you will see just a glimpse of the outworking of an incredible collaboration between a loving and mighty God and his people.

Breakthrough: Life FM expands into the capital

He wāwāhi ara. Kei te whakarahi ake a Life FM ki te taone matua

'Jesus looked at them intently and said, "Humanly speaking, it is impossible. But with God everything is possible."' Matthew 19:26 NLT

In June 2021, a breakthrough happened for Life FM – humanly speaking it seemed impossible to achieve, but God made a way.

Since Christian radio began 43 years ago with a single station toe-hold in Christchurch, there have been two significant dark zones in the country with no Christian FM radio coverage. Neither Christchurch, the second largest city, nor Wellington, the third largest city in the country, have been covered by FM.

People from those locations have long prayed to have Christian radio on the FM band for their young people to hear life-changing messages of grace, faith, hope and love inspired by the Good News of Jesus Christ.

Wendy from Wellington wrote in in 2018: 'I listen to Life FM via streaming, for its wholesome talk and songs (which all helps when you struggle with negative thoughts etc). In times when life is hard, Life FM keeps me focused on what is important and reminds me that our almighty God is sovereign and in control of everything. I will be someone who will benefit from Life FM coming here.'

Now, 60 years after God originally gave Richard Berry the vision to reach New Zealanders with Christian radio, God has made it possible for people in the capital city to finally listen to a Christian FM radio station.

This breakthrough has been a long time coming. There are a limited number of FM licences, and they are rarely available especially in the main centres like Wellington and Christchurch. When they are made available via auction the sale price has been prohibitive. As an example, during the last FM frequency auction in 2014, when two FM frequencies were available in Wellington, one sold for \$900,000 and the other for \$2 million.

Since 2017, Rhema Media's Prayer Warriors have been asked to regularly pray for a breakthrough for FM coverage in these two cities, along with some





other important markets. And for Wellington, God made the humanly impossible God-possible! He opened the way to re-engineer and re-position the existing Life FM frequency in Porirua with a reach of 50,000 or so people. This would mean that Life FM could expand into the greater Wellington region with a reach of around 377,000 souls.

However, while that makes it sound easy, it has still been a three-year battle to realise the opportunity. As is often the case with attempts to expand the reach of Christian media in New Zealand, there has been resistance. But with the licence granted and Life FM on air we give God the glory for this breakthrough and thank everyone who helped make it possible - those who caught the vision for Life FM broadcasting in the capital and gave to the 'Key To The Capital' appeal, and those in the industry who supported the move. Thank you.

Rhema Media Chief Executive Andrew Fraser says, 'To be able to have impact in our communities and in individuals' lives we need to be able to reach them. In Romans 10:14 (CEV) we read, *'How can people have faith in the Lord and ask him to save them, if they have never heard about him? And how can they hear, unless someone tells them?'* That is why we are all super-excited to have Life FM on a full power frequency covering the whole of Wellington, our capital city and the centre of Government. Now that we have this breakthrough after so many years of prayer, we

are expecting to hear and see great stories of lives changed through the messages of hope, love and grace broadcast over this city.'

Content Director for Life FM Luke Weston says, 'For 23 years Life FM has broadcast around Aotearoa, New Zealand and God has used the radio station to impact hearts and homes over that time. We say that Life FM is 'Faith, Music, and Culture' and it is amazing to have launched the station into Wellington so that more Kiwis can hear the unique message that Life FM brings. On a personal note, the fact that this was enabled by hundreds of people who gave to our 'Key To The Capital' appeal is an amazing feeling. This move has the mandate of our supporters and God's people in New Zealand. To God be the glory.'

This is a breakthrough that you helped God to make possible through support of your Christian media ministry. Please join us in continuing to pray for a breakthrough with FM coverage in other key centres, especially Christchurch.



Increased accessibility for Shine TV **Whakawātea ake te whai urunga kia Shine TV**

God has always miraculously provided for Rhema Media to be able to adopt the latest technology and media platforms to reach the people of Aotearoa, New Zealand with the Good News of Jesus. This is one way in which God has dedicated himself to making a way for your Christian media ministry to expand.

In the last few years, through your investment, Shine TV, your Kiwi Christian channel, has expanded from traditional linear viewing to include access on a number of digital platforms.

In 2019, Shine On Demand was officially launched, providing thousands of hours of family-friendly and uplifting TV shows, movies, teaching, documentaries and much more. The Shine team is constantly adding new shows to the on demand platform, including New Zealand-made teaching programmes,

documentaries and music shows. And, what's exciting is that viewers can now also access livestreams from church events and conferences across the country, exclusively on Shine On Demand.

But, there's more! In early 2021, Shine and Shine On Demand became available via an App. This means increased accessibility for Shine TV viewers – the ability to access Shine TV at a click of a button on their portable smart devices and to watch their choice of life-changing content at any time. It's a personal doorway to programming that can change their lives.

Your support of your Christian media ministry makes significant developments like this possible. It is this adaptation to an ever-changing media climate that allows people to access Christian television that draws people into an increasingly meaningful, personal relationship with Jesus Christ.

Election 2020 Coverage: Our Nation, Our Voice ***Te hōkaitanga pōti 2020. Tō tātou whenua. Tō tātou Reo***

Thank you. Your support enabled your Christian media ministry to provide extensive coverage on a range of issues and policies in the lead up to New Zealand's 2020 general election.

In the 'Our Nation, Our Voice: Election 2020' coverage on Rhema Media, the on air team had robust one-on-one and panel conversations on key election issues and two referenda, with a range of political party leaders and leading Christian thinkers, experts and communicators.

These conversations were broadcast on Rhema, Life FM, Star and Shine TV, and on social media, in September and October. They were then available on demand for people to watch in their own time.

The election coverage culminated with a day of prayer on Friday 16th October across all your Christian media ministry brands. Christian leaders and people from around the country prayed for the election and the future leaders of the nation.

The response to Rhema Media's election coverage was extremely positive. After The Panel discussion on the Māori Perspective, Piki commented, 'I'll be sharing this kōrero in my course for academics, ngā mihi aroha.'

It was a privilege to provide faith-based perspectives on election issues for New Zealanders – thus helping them to make informed decisions for voting in the general election. Thank you for making it possible for God's heart on these issues to be heard across the country.





Tiriti o Waitangi: Connecting with the spiritual significance ***Te Tiriti o Waitangi: Te hononga nui ki te wairua***

As a result of your support of Rhema Media, the spiritual significance of Tiriti o Waitangi (The Treaty of Waitangi) can be reflected on, understood, celebrated and shared with people across Aotearoa, New Zealand.

In February 2021, your Christian media ministry's team was on the ground at the annual Waitangi Day commemorations. Coverage included live broadcasts on Waitangi Day, including the dawn ceremony and the interdenominational church service. The team highlighted and shared the importance, culture and story of Waitangi Day for all people of New Zealand from a Christian perspective.

In the lead up to Waitangi Day, Shine TV screened a live broadcast from 'Open Heaven', an annual combined churches prayer event at Spark Arena in Auckland. Here people of all denominations

gathered to seek God and ask for his will to be done in New Zealand, as it is in Heaven.

And, back in the Shine TV studio, Te Ope Whakaora (Salvation Army Māori Ministries) recorded 'Worship At Waitangi' – a three-day live worship event with a range of Christian Kiwi music artists. This was available via multiple online streams and broadcast on Shine TV leading up to Waitangi Day. It was a privilege to collaborate with The Te Ope Whakaora in this significant worship event.

These programmes and other Waitangi features are still available to watch on Shine On Demand.

She had never met him, until the day he came to say hello to her at the Rhema Media offices. Juanita touched his heart with her care and faithfulness.

Jo, one Rhema Media's sales account managers, tells this story: 'On a cold

winters day, while pulling up to a bakery for my lunch, there right in front of me was a frail woman huddled in a doorway reading a Bible. She was asking for money to pay her rent. My heart broke. I sat with her as she told me her story and battle with cancer. I got her lunch, gave her money for her rent and a bag of clothes I had in my car, that didn't fit me but were perfect for her. As I drove Anita home, the biggest gift to me was talking to her about faith and the value of money, as she had just called Rhema for prayer - within the hour I crossed her path. Her prayer was answered in a real way that touched us both.'

Rhema Media's regular events and road trips around the country throughout the year, to meet face to face with listeners and viewers, are a highlight for the team. Many of our audience share that Rhema Media is like family and friends to them; the Rhema Media team is just as blessed, encouraged and inspired through these personal meetings.

As you read through this year's annual report, we pray that you are inspired and encouraged by the stories of how God has worked to draw people into an increasingly meaningful and personal relationship with his Son Jesus through Christian media.

In the last year, Rhema Media united with other ministries to help bring healing and hope for the future to many around the world, thanks to the generosity of Rhema Media listeners.

On the 1st October, a team from The Leprosy Mission took calls in the Rhema Media office during an on-air appeal to gain sponsorships to heal people of leprosy. On the day, 527 people with leprosy were sponsored by Rhema, Star and Life FM listeners and will be set free from the disease.

Later in October, Rhema was able to partner with CBM (Christian Blind Mission) for Miracles Day. Together, Rhema listeners raised enough money for CBM to provide over 1,000 miracle cataract surgeries that will restore sight – and life

In 2020, The Word For Today New Zealand celebrated its 25th birthday! And, Word For You Today, re-written for the younger generation, celebrated impacting young Kiwi lives for ten years.

In August last year, a prison chaplain wrote in: 'The first reading in the latest issue of The Word For Today was a real encouragement for the men in the prison - "You Can Bounce Back". An inmate reminded me of this the day we went into lockdown again. The booklets went as quickly as ever. The small reserve we keep aside, to give to those who come after our distribution, has gone. The men receive a huge amount of encouragement from these daily readings.'

And Louise shared: 'Word For You Today means a lot to me. It has seen me through some desperate dark days. It is also there when things are good. It motivates me and draws me close, often relating to my daily Bible readings. There is nothing like holding it in your hand while you read, with the Bible beside you. I do not think I would be here if I had not picked up my first free copy.'

And, to celebrate ten years of publication, Word For You Today enjoyed a refresh of logo and colour, reflecting its outreach to the young people of Aotearoa, New Zealand.

Your support of these daily devotionals has helped to ensure that hundreds of thousands of people receive daily words of encouragement from Jesus for their lives. They read these words through their printed devotionals or via Facebook or Instagram or on their app, or they hear it read out on Rhema, Life FM and Star.

The writer of these devotionals, Bob Gass, said, 'I want to get God's Word into the hands of as many people as possible during my lifetime.' Bob passed away in 2019, but his work continues.

You play such a big role in drawing people closer to Jesus Christ through these daily devotionals. Thank you so much!

Basis of Presentation

Annual General Meeting

(a) Statement of compliance

The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with New Zealand Generally Accepted Accounting Practice ("NZ GAAP"). They comply with Public Benefit Entity International Public Sector Accounting Standards and other applicable Financial Reporting Standards (collectively "PBE Standards"), as appropriate for Tier 2 not-for-profit public benefit entities, for which all reduced disclosure regime exemptions have been adopted. The Society qualifies as a Tier 2 reporting entity as for the two most recent reporting periods it has had between \$2 million and \$30 million operating expenditure.

These financial statements were authorised for issue by the Board on 6th July 2021.

(b) Measurement basis

The financial statements have been prepared on the historical cost basis except for the Land and Building, which are stated at valuation.

(c) Functional and presentation currency

The financial statements are presented in New Zealand dollars (\$) which is the Society's functional and presentation currency. Unless otherwise stated, amounts are rounded to the nearest thousand dollars.
